

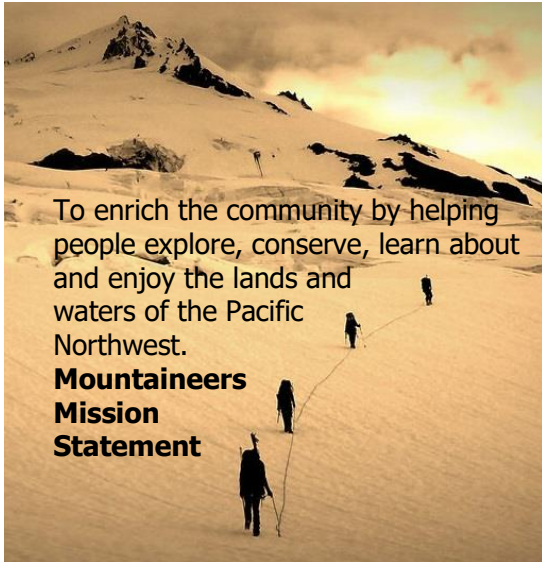


About the Mountaineers
